Since the 1980's, my grazier customers kept asking me to produce a "buffalo fly" oil to carry their insecticide. In the past, they reused sump oil that worked quite well **BUT** left the cattle marked, their hides "stained" and was contaminating the meat. They then tried vegetable oil, which the cattle loved. When the cattle could not lick anymore oil off the back rubbers, they chewed them to pieces. They told me that as the oil (which carried the insecticide) went straight through the cattle, the active ingredient killed off a great percentage of their 'dung beetles'.

In 2001-2002 I supplied my **BackRubber Oil** to some of my grazier customers with samples for testing, and it was very gratifying to have them buying replacement oil.

One of my customers had a visitor who later remarked to his superiors, that it was good to see the cattle with no flies and better still, no stains from dirty oil on their hides. Since **Bimrose BackRubber Oil's** release, graziers can now watch their cattle graze and put on weight instead of running around trying to get rid of flies and *losing weight*, while horse owners have found it to be a deterrent to march flies.

It is unfortunate that some are still using used sump oil and even hydraulic oil, the practice of which could have complete shipments of meat rejected overseas, if and when detected this could bankrupt the individual responsible. **Bimrose BackRubber Oil** is a product, which **DOES NOT** contain un-recycled mineral oil, and is designed to carry your selected brand of registered Buffalo Fly Treatment

This product is a pure mineral oil Carrier *for registered* Buffalo Fly Treatments. **NO DRIP, NO WASTE.** This product does not drip from rubbers or cattle. It is not as pleasant tasting as vegetable oil, therefore there is no licking from each other or back rubbers and in turn **does not** harm the Dung Beetle.

There are concerns that potentially cancer causing chemicals formed by high temperature combustion engines are in the sump oil. Therefore, the use of sump oil is NOT consistent with Australia's 'Clean and Green' marketing position. Clean unused mineral oils are recommended. One Queensland lubricant supplier has specially formulated a mineral oil product for use with back rubbers. Recycled engine oils are not recommended as the recycling process may not remove the carcinogenic chemicals. Furthermore, Vegetable oils can no longer be recommended as an alternative. Some are overly palatable to cattle and may encourage more self and mutual grooming that would lead to the increased ingestion of the chemical. Such chemical absorption may poison stock or at least increase the chemical residue level within the animal. There are also reports that some vegetable oils may spontaneously ignite or degenerate into gluggy, unusable compounds.
